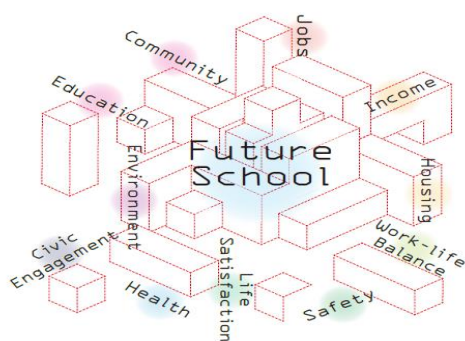




International Student Innovation Forum 2020 @online

On 11-12 August 2020, Innovative School Network (ISN) organized the **International Student Innovation Forum 2020 (ISIF2020) Live Talk** via online. About 200 students and 100 adults from 9 countries and economies (Indonesia, Malaysia, Guatemala, Hong Kong, Chinese Taipei, Philippines, Turkey, Vietnam and Japan) participated. They shared challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic and discussed the topic of School Well-being as a response to COVID-19 and to create future looking learning systems to meet the needs of the 21st century. In order to discuss School Well-being with broader perspectives, the OECD's Better Life Index (BLI)¹ with the 11 themes were used as a frame of the discussion. Even though it is virtually organized, ISIF2020 focused on lively interactions among participants and genuine learning so that participants' sense of agency resonate with each others'.

As opening remarks, Professor **Hiroshi Suzuki** (Chairman of ISN) encouraged participants to

enjoy the discussion and to make a new epoch together. Then, representative students from participating countries shared their current challenges and aspirations for participating in the ISIF2020. **Eda** and **Lily** witnessed that during the school closure, they missed opportunities of contacting teachers and getting feedback easily and quickly. **Kinki** mentioned how online learning made students actively think of different ways to involve themselves in lessons rather than passively receiving knowledge. **Kai** expressed his enthusiasm of sharing and learning with each other, and **Nur'Izzatul** appreciated technologies which can connect us and interact with each other. **Danya** and **Karlo** addressed how thousands of people are hungry, unemployed and dying. Many students have been forced to drop out from school and we have to be conscious of one another. Despite the challenges, **Jose** expressed a single pandemic will not make his country stop from moving forward, and **Kim** also expressed as the youth, we are the pioneers and the foundations of tomorrow.
